The LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Green Building Rating System™ is a voluntary, consensus-based national standard for developing high-performance, sustainable buildings. It is a self-assessing measurement tool, based on a credit system which focuses on a number of design and construction strategies aimed at reducing a building's environmental footprint.

Sprint Waste is a leader in helping contractors earn LEED Construction Waste Management Credits.

The intent of the Construction Waste Management Credit:

- To divert construction, demolition, packaging, and land-clearing debris from disposal in landfills or incinerators
- To redirect recyclable recovered resources back to the manufacturing process
- To redirect reusable materials to appropriate sites

Sprint Waste's LEED efforts involve:

Working with the contractor to ensure that material generated on the job site is properly reused and recycled to maximize your credits.

On-Site Sorting:

- Sprint Waste provides roll-off boxes for each recyclable material.
- Contractor sorts material on-site.
- Sprint Waste transports roll-off boxes to designated recycling facility.

Off-Site Sorting:

- All recyclables go into one box.
- Sprint Waste sorts and separates recyclables off-site.
- Sprint Waste processes or transports the materials to the appropriate recycling facility.
